



Canine Physiotherapy

Has your dog had an injury or surgery?
Is your dog stiff when moving about?
Have you noticed performance problems?

Physiotherapy can help the following common complaints:-

- Joint problems (arthritis/degenerative joint disease, injury, pain/swelling/stiffness)
- Injuries – to muscles, ligaments, tendons
- Sports injuries
- Spinal problems
- Post surgical rehabilitation and fractures
- Performance difficulties in the athletic dog
- Preventative physiotherapy can help minimise recurrence of a problem

Physiotherapy treatment includes:-

- Manipulation and mobilisation to joints and soft tissues
- Massage and soft tissue techniques
- Electrotherapies such as ultrasound and laser, neuromuscular electrical stimulation and electromagnetic therapy
- Exercise regimes and rehabilitation
